# OPERATION SHIELD

- More than 140 cameras installed and integrated
- Today, more than 8,200 connected in the Operation Shield Video Integration Center (VIC), **expecting to exceed 9,000 by end of June.**
- 25 to 45 percent reduction in crime in areas with cameras city wide.

# SECURE NEIGHBORHOODS

**Our goal is to build twenty-five homes by 2020 on the Westside and expand Atlanta Police housing from 5 to 15 homes in 2017.**

## DID YOU KNOW:

- 25 of the top 100 juvenile offenders are in the age range of 12-to-14
- In 2016, APD made more than 1100 juvenile arrests, for various crimes
- Data shows that 5 juveniles are responsible for at 128 crimes and have 101 arrests between them



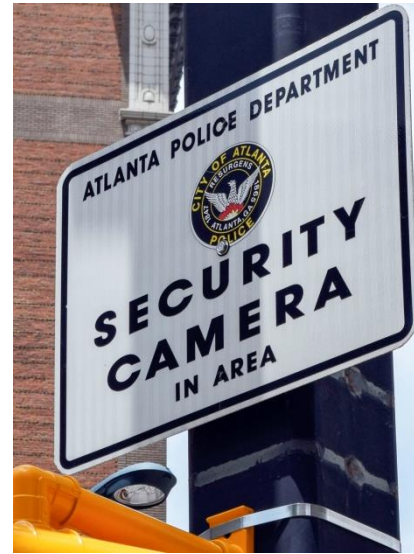
