 - *Apprehended three males breaking into vehicles**





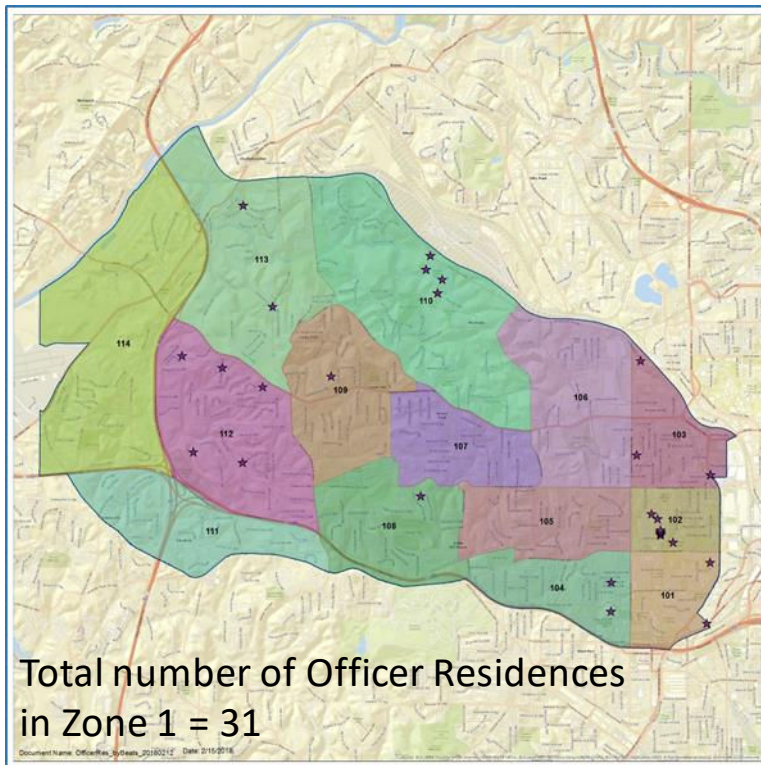

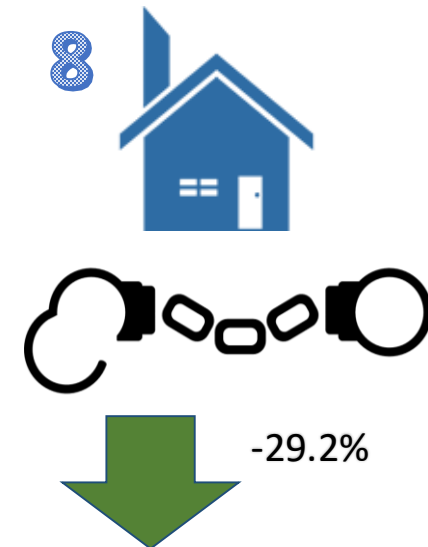
Secure Neighborhoods | Increased Police Visibility

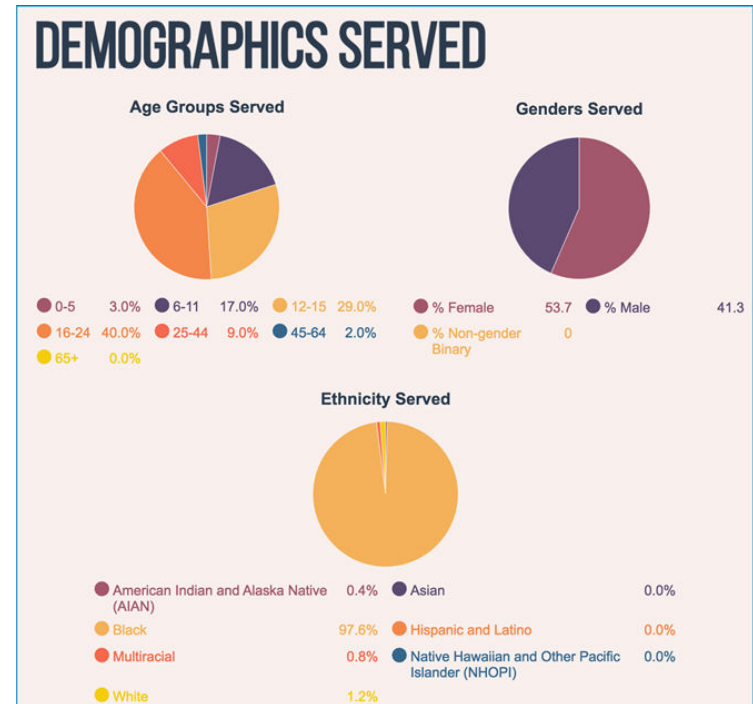

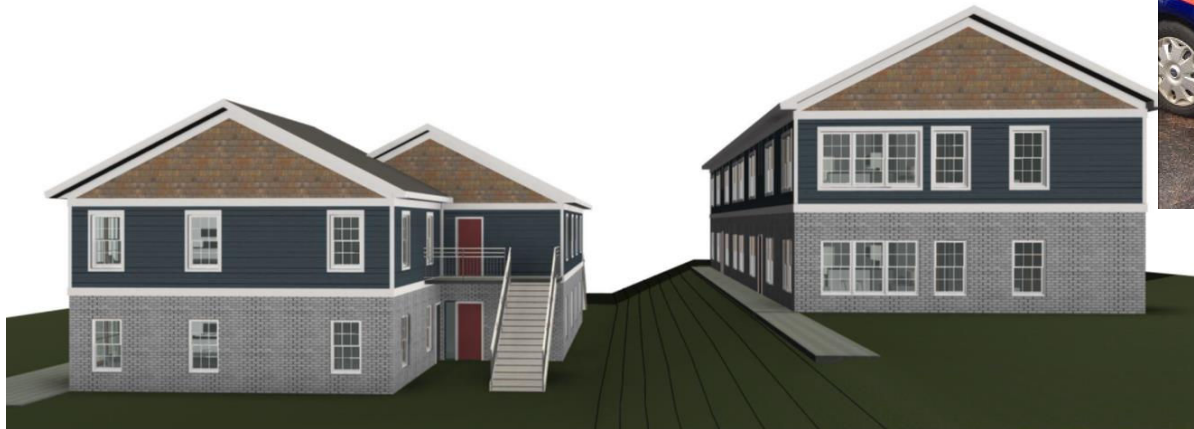

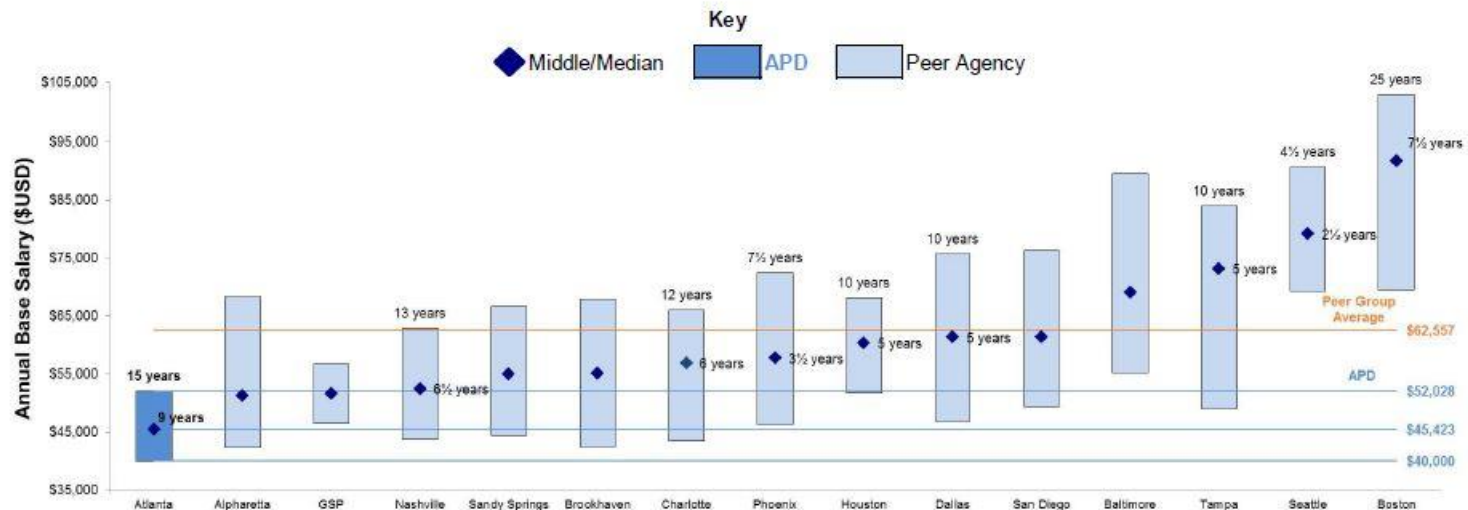

POSITION-LEVEL PAY PLAN RANGE COMPARISON POLICE OFFICER

- The pay plan range for APD Police Officers overlaps with the ranges of eleven of the fourteen peer agencies, although APD's starting pay is below each peer agency and upper-tier pay is below those of the peers
- The number of years of tenure in-rank required to reach both the middle and maximum of APD's Police Officer pay range is greater than that of nearly every other peer agency despite having the lowest middle and maximum of the peer group. Three of the peer agencies max out Police Officers after 10 years



Data for the Police Officer rank is available for all peer agencies

Note: The number of years denote the tenure required in-rank to reach the middle and the maximum of the pay plan
