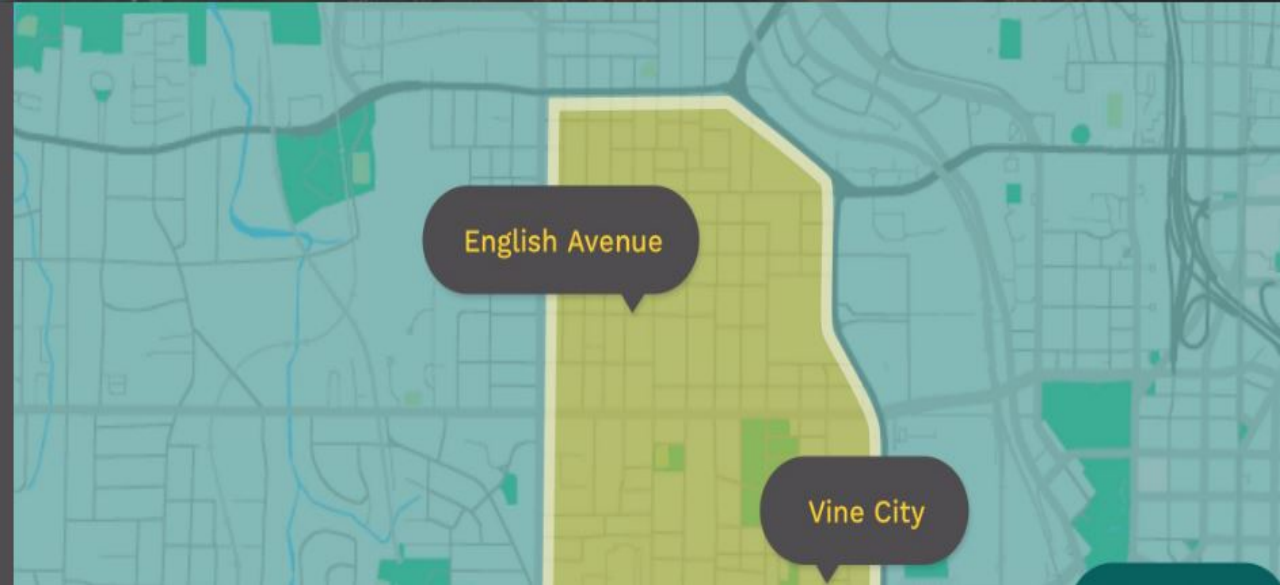
The Westside is vital for all of Atlanta to thrive.
